

Duluth Soccer League (DSL) - PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, captains, volunteers, administrators, and officials at every game.

I will comply with all league game rules.

I will treat everyone with respect regardless of race, religion, color, national origin, sex, gender, sexual orientation, age, or ability.

I will not berate the officials.

I will not post demeaning or abusive comments about players, captains, volunteers, administrators, or officials on social media.

I will show respect for all facilities and other property hosting DSL events.

I will communicate my concerns through the board or a team captain in a dignified manner.

By registering for a DSL program I agree in full with this code of conduct and understand that any violation of it may result in my dismissal from a game, a team, or temporary or permanent dismissal from participation in DSL as a whole.

DSL asks players, captains, board members and referees who may have, or witness, an experience contrary to its code of conduct or culture statement to report concerns to league leadership in whatever way they are most comfortable. Anonymity will be respected, and we will address all offenses to the best of our ability. Willingness to provide contact information with such reports will allow transparent conversations and help us ensure the most appropriate action is taken. Thank you.
