NKCA Baseball Members,

NKCA Baseball is coming off a big spring season, seeing over a 20%+ increase in participation across age groups from 6U TBall through our high school age groups. We appreciate all those who played in the spring season and allow us to be your league of choice. We are now getting close to wrapping up the spring season and Fall Ball just around the corner. As we look back on the spring season, here are a few accomplishments worth celebrating...

- The grounds crews have done a remarkable job in keeping our complexes up and running. Our fields have never looked and played better than they do now.
- Our age specific fields have allowed the game to be played consistent with its design. Where a home run by a 7U player is a legitimate home run!! We present players with a 1st Home Run trophy case, complete with an interview. This program allows us to celebrate one of the most exciting moments in a young athlete's experience.
- Our TBall program went to the absolute next level in 2026. With reduced roster sizes to increase at bats and development around fundamental skills through targeted drills for players being introduced to the game. The inaugural season was a huge success and we gained a great deal of knowledge and best practices as we go into fall and future seasons.

The Fall Ball program is viewed as a preparatory season for what age teams will be playing in the spring (for example, teams that played 11U in the Spring will most likely play 12U in the Fall as that will be the age they will play in the next Spring season).

Below is information on our 2026 Fall program. As always, please do not hesitate to call or email the league with any questions.

Registration – Will Open 7/01/2026 for teams and players.

- **Player League fees will be due no later than 8/10/2026.**
- Coach / Team / Player registration (click on a link to complete registration)

 - **These steps need to be complete, with a full/paid roster, before a schedule can be made for your team.**
- Historically, the league has played 6U to High School ages in the Fall. If there continues to be interest we will allow teams to register for the **6U T-Ball, Coach Pitch, and Machine Pitch divisions**. If you are interested in coaching a team for these age groups, please let us know.

Fall Scheduling

- We have moved to the season starting after Labor Day. We anticipate beginning our season the **week of 9/8/26**. Each age group will have **10 games (2 per week) + a postseason tournament**. With some weather days built in, we anticipate **finishing up no later than 10/26/2026**.

- **DH Sunday League** – Based on popular demand, we are returning with a DH Sunday league for teams that require this type of schedule. Please keep in mind that the skill set of the team is not a consideration when requesting this type of schedule. In addition, it is difficult to schedule when requesting to play DH Sundays and then request Sundays off for tournaments.
- The league will play throughout the week and weekends, allowing teams to let us know of any schedule exceptions by the use of the [conflict form](#) found under Home/Online Forms on our website. **Managers only** should submit a conflict form by **8/10/26** to provide us with the dates/days that their team **cannot** play. If the team intends to play in Sunday DH's, please indicate as such in the comments section of this form.
