FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. What day/time are practices?

A. Practice day/time is not guaranteed! Decide now whether you would still like to register. Practices are scheduled according to the coach schedule only. It's impossible to work around hundreds of individual players schedules. Practice days/times are 1day/1hr per week M-F, usually, 6-7pm, 7-8pm or 8-9pm. The older kids are given the latter. Possible Sunday afternoon practices.

2. What happens if my child gets a practice day on the same day as one of their other activities (dance, volleyball, football, karate, baseball, etc)?

A. There is NO swithing teams or refunds issued after teams are drafted. You must communicate with your coach. Game time will be up to coach discretion for players who are unable to attend/miss practices.

3. When will I hear from a coach regarding practice or game schedules?

A. Practices will not begin till after the coach clinic in early December. Games will begin first or second Saturday January.

4. What else will my child need to participate?

A. Athletic shorts (usually black), athletic shoes, WATER ONLY bottle w/ name labeled, ball for practices.

*Players are provided reversible Spurs League jerseys that are not to be altered or utilized in any other leagues for the duration of the FYBL/SYBL season.

5. What size ball does my child need?

A. 5/6 Coed Division uses a 27.5, All other age groups use 28.5

6. How are teams formed?

A. Floresville teams are alphabetized by division on a list. We have all head coaches only attend a draft. Each coach draws a number and takes turns picking players off the list. Assistant coach player should be picked first if known with coach kid picked fourth. Continue picking on their turn till the names on the list are exhausted. Out of town teams are formed if 10 players register to form a team. If less than 10 or more than 10/less than 20 register, the last to register will be asked to join the Floresville draft or may receive a refund. If there are only enough to form 2 teams each coach will get their child and one other pick from the list. The rest of the players will be a blind drafted to each team. If there are 3+ teams in a town division the draft will be conducted the same as the Floresville draft.

*Only siblings, in the same age division and living at the same address, will be guaranteed placement on the same team if requested.

**Out of Town Teams: These are teams of players that do not attend any Floresville area school and will most likely practice in their own town. ie..LV, Poth, FC. However, not guaranteed. be sure to specify your preference of town to practice during registration.

7. <u>I signed up to coach. Now what?</u>

A. FYBL will run a background check on all coaches, assistants and volunteers with the league. All assistants/volunteers must fill out coach paperwork. Head coaches will be contacted about the draft time/date by text. At each draft coaches, will fill out a practice request schedule giving up top 3 days/times you are available to practice. Coaches that coach 2+ teams will be given priority scheduling. We will post your practice times on the SportsPlus App so the team can view. League rules are posted on our webpage: floresvilleyouthbasketball.org. All coaches will be contacted to attend a MANDATORY in person coach training session, first week of December. Out of town coaches, there IS limited room to practice in Floresville. If you choose elsewhere, FYBL will not handle any logistics on practices(contracts/fees/location); however, you must adhere to league practice guidelines. We can get you a copy of our league insurance upon request for additional facilities.

8. <u>League Schedules</u>

A. Download the SportsPlus App if you do not already have it and login. Schedules will be posted here along with team assignments. If you need to be added as a parent to your child's team just shoot us an email.
