- -October meeting minutes were read and approved 8-0.
- -Treasurer's report: John reported that there is \$9,003 in the account.
- -Tom presented the proposed Rule #31 regarding late registrants. After discussion it was voted on and approved 8-0.
- -Rick presented the proposal to move Masters starting pitch count to 1-1. That was voted on and approved 8-0.
