SUBJECT: Sports Budget/Fees for 2025 -2026

The 2025-2026 sports budget will be managed by the Commissioner and District Office level for LUSD teams. **Newcastle and Harvest Ridge will manage their own sports budgets and are determined at their sites.**

LUSD: Franklin, Loomis, LBCS, Placer, Penryn, Ophir, H. Clarke Powers

Newcastle Elementary School and Loomis Basin Charter School is charged a league participation fee of \$1000 and is responsible for 1/8 of the cost of boys and girls LBAL league basketball and volleyball referees fees for all league and tournament games. Harvest Ridge is charged a league participation fee of \$285 and is responsible for their share of the cost of cross country and track and field medals and banners.

LEAGUE FEES

Commissioner: \$5000 for the year

Athletic Director: \$1800 for the year per LUSD school

Athletic Coaches: \$1,410 LUSD Certificated or Classified Employee
\$800 Non- LUSD employee (walk-on coach)

Officials: Negotiated with CIF associations for basketball and volleyball

Transportation: As needed basis – charged to the school site not the LBAL budget

Maximum coaches stipends per school based on participation:

- Cross country 2 per school
- Girls Basketball 2 per school
- Boys Volleyball 2 per school
- Boys Basketball 2 per school
- Wrestling 2 per District
- Girls Volleyball 2 per school
- Track 2 per school

All LUSD participating schools are responsible for funding the difference between the site sports participation fee collections and the funds collected through any donations toward athletics.

Schools are responsible for the following expenses. Should the end of the year LBAL budget balance exceed LBAL expenses, schools will be reimbursed site costs. The LBAL is a zero sum organization. School costs may initially include:

- Officials outside of league costs
- Transportation costs
- Awards
- Uniforms
- Equipment

Funding sources:

- Student/athlete participation fee of \$60 per sport
- Snack bar revenues
- Tournament attendance revenue
- Other as determined by each school
