Players

- Give Your Best: Effort matters more than perfection. Hustle, listen, and compete with integrity.

- Positive Attitude: Your body language and words should lift the team, not weigh it down.
- Learn From Mistakes: Every error is a chance to grow—accept feedback and adjust.
- Balance First: Schoolwork and family come before basketball. Manage your responsibilities.
- **Pride in Representation:** Wear the LNH name with honor on and off the court.
- Have Fun: Compete hard, enjoy the game, and remember why you started playing.

Parents & Guardians

- **Support, Don't Coach:** Encourage your child and the team. Leave the teaching and game decisions to the coaches.
- **Positive Role Model:** Cheer with respect. Coaches handle referees—let them.
- **Communication Standards:** If an issue arises, please wait 24 hours before approaching a coach. Follow the proper communication chain.
- Attendance Commitment: Practice matters. Missing practice may impact playing time. Notify coaches at least a day in advance if your child will be absent.
- Represent the Community: Your behavior in the stands reflects on LNH. Model sportsmanship at all times.
