I understand and agree that my child's participation in MTRA sports is voluntary. I acknowledge that participation in recreational and competitive sports naturally involves a range of risks, which may include minor injuries, more serious injuries, or, in rare instances, life-altering injuries. While MTRA takes reasonable precautions to promote a safe environment, injuries cannot be entirely prevented. I voluntarily assume these risks on behalf of my child and have instructed my child to follow all rules, regulations, and instructions provided by MTRA coaches, volunteers, and officials.

I understand that if my child becomes ill or injured during participation, I will be contacted as soon as possible and agree to arrange prompt pickup if requested.

In the event of a medical emergency, my signature authorizes MTRA officials, coaches, and volunteers to act according to their best judgment in securing appropriate medical treatment for my child. I grant permission for emergency medical treatment and/or routine medical care by emergency medical services (EMS), hospital personnel, or other licensed healthcare providers as deemed necessary. Any such action will be taken in the best interest of my child and I will be notified as soon as reasonably possible.

I further grant permission for MTRA to arrange transportation of my child to a local hospital or medical facility if such transport is deemed necessary for my child's welfare.
