Section 1 – Athlete Code of Conduct

- Respect coaches, teammates, officials, and opponents at all times.
- Follow all team safety rules and coaching instructions.
- No fighting, bullying, taunting, or inappropriate language.
- Arrive on time and prepared for all activities.
- Maintain issued equipment responsibly.
- Represent 205 Texans positively in school, community, and online.
- Refrain from drugs, alcohol, vaping, or illegal substances.

Section 2 – Parent/Guardian Code of Conduct

- Respect coaching authority and game officials.
- Follow the 24-hour rule before addressing concerns.
- No sideline coaching or public confrontation.
- Maintain respectful conduct in person and on social media.
- Ensure athlete punctuality and preparedness.

Section 3 – Concussion Protocol (Illinois Youth Sports Concussion Safety Act)

In compliance with Illinois law, any athlete suspected of sustaining a concussion or head injury will be immediately removed from play and may not return until evaluated and cleared in writing by a licensed healthcare professional. Parents acknowledge receipt of concussion education materials and understand the signs, symptoms, and risks associated with head injuries.

Section 4 – Payment Policy & Strict No-Refund Clause

All registration fees, deposits, fundraising commitments, and participation payments are STRICTLY NON-REFUNDABLE. This applies to voluntary withdrawal, injury, disciplinary removal, scheduling conflicts, relocation, or any other reason. By signing below, Parent/Guardian acknowledges and agrees that no refunds, credits, or transfers will be issued under any circumstances. Failure to meet payment obligations may result in suspension or permanent removal from team activities.

Section 5 – Assumption of Risk & Liability Waiver (Illinois)

Tackle football is a contact sport involving inherent risks including serious bodily injury, permanent disability, paralysis, or death. Parent/Guardian voluntarily assumes all risks associated with participation.

Parent/Guardian hereby releases, waives, and holds harmless 205 Texans Youth Football, its directors, coaches, volunteers, sponsors, and affiliated facilities from any and all liability, claims, demands, or causes of action permitted under Illinois law arising out of participation in team activities.

Section 6 – Medical Authorization

In the event of a medical emergency, Parent/Guardian authorizes team officials to seek medical treatment for the athlete if Parent/Guardian cannot be reached.
