ATHLETE COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT REFUNDABLE DEPOSIT AGREEMENT

This Athlete Community Engagement Refundable Deposit Agreement (“Agreement”) is entered into by and between Patriots of Wellen Park Football and Cheer Organization (“Organization”) and the undersigned Parent/Guardian on behalf of the registered participant (“Athlete”).

1. PURPOSE

The Organization is committed to developing well-rounded student-athletes who demonstrate leadership, character, discipline, and community responsibility.

To support this mission, a \$150.00 refundable community engagement deposit (“Deposit”) is required for each registered Athlete. The Deposit is not a participation fee and is held conditionally in accordance with the terms set forth herein.

2. COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT REQUIREMENT

To qualify for a full refund of the \$150.00 Deposit, the Athlete must complete six (6) verified community engagement hours during the official season.

Eligible engagement activities include Organization-sponsored service projects, community initiatives, charitable outreach events, youth mentorship programs, appreciation events, donation drives, and other nonprofit service activities pre-approved in writing by the Executive Board.

All engagement hours must:

- Be completed during the designated season timeframe;
- Be organized, sponsored, or pre-approved by the Organization;
- Be personally performed by the Athlete (not a parent or third party);
- Be properly documented and verified by an authorized Organization representative.

Unverified or undocumented hours will not be credited.

3. REFUND TERMS

Upon verification of six (6) completed engagement hours, the \$150.00 Deposit shall be refunded within thirty (30) days following season completion or written confirmation of fulfillment.

If the Athlete does not complete the required six (6) hours, the Deposit shall be forfeited and retained by the Organization to further support its nonprofit mission.

No partial refunds shall be issued except at the sole discretion of the Executive Board due to documented medical incapacity or extraordinary hardship.

4. VOLUNTARY DONATION ELECTION

The Parent/Guardian may elect at any time to donate the \$150.00 Deposit to the Organization in lieu of receiving a refund. If a donation election is made, the Deposit shall be deemed a voluntary and irrevocable charitable contribution. A written acknowledgment may be provided upon request. The Organization makes no representation regarding tax deductibility; families should consult a qualified tax professional.

Optional Donation Election:

5. EARLY WITHDRAWAL OR DISMISSAL

If the Athlete withdraws, is suspended, or is dismissed for disciplinary reasons prior to completing the required engagement hours, the Deposit may be forfeited at the discretion of the Executive Board.

6. NON-TRANSFERABILITY

The Deposit is non-transferable between athletes, may not be credited toward future seasons without written Board approval, and may not be applied toward other balances without authorization.

7. GOVERNING LAW

This Agreement shall be governed by the Organization's bylaws, policies, and the laws of the State of Florida.
