PARTICIPANT WAIVER, RELEASE OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK & MEDIA CONSENT

These terms apply to participation in any Bald Eagle Sports Inc. program, including but not limited to AAU travel teams, development leagues, summer camps, clinics, tryouts, practices, games, tournaments, team travel, and any other current or future Bald Eagle Sports program (each, a "Program"). Please read carefully — by registering your child for a Program, you and your child agree to the terms below.

1. Assumption of Risk

Basketball and related athletic activity involve inherent risks of physical injury, including but not limited to:

- Collisions, falls, and contact with other participants, coaches, officials, or equipment
- Sprains, strains, fractures, dislocations, concussions, and other head, neck, or spinal injuries
- Heat-related illness, dehydration, and exposure to weather during outdoor or travel activities
- Exposure to communicable illness through close contact with other participants
- Injury during transportation to or from practices, games, tournaments, or team travel
- Injury arising from the condition of a facility, court, or equipment not owned or controlled by Bald Eagle Sports Inc.

These risks cannot be eliminated regardless of the care taken to avoid injury. By registering your child, you are choosing for them to participate with full knowledge of these risks.

2. Release and Waiver of Liability

In consideration of your child being permitted to participate in a Program, you, on behalf of yourself, your child, and your respective heirs and legal representatives, release and forever discharge Bald Eagle Sports Inc., its owners, officers, directors, employees, coaches, staff, volunteers, contractors, and the owners of any facility or venue used for a Program (collectively, the "Released Parties"), from any and all claims, demands, losses, or causes of action arising out of ordinary negligence in connection with participation in a Program, to the fullest extent permitted by California law.

This release does not apply to, and nothing in this agreement waives, any claim arising from the gross negligence, recklessness, or willful or wanton misconduct of a Released Party, to the extent such a waiver is prohibited under California law.

3. Indemnification

You agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Released Parties from any loss, liability, damage, or cost they may incur arising out of your child's participation in a Program, except to the extent caused by the gross negligence or willful misconduct of a Released Party.

4. Medical Treatment Authorization

If your child becomes ill or injured during a Program and you cannot immediately be reached, you authorize Bald Eagle Sports Inc. staff to obtain emergency medical care for your child, including transport to a medical facility, and you agree to be responsible for any associated medical costs. Please make sure our office has current information on

file about your child's allergies, medical conditions, medications, and health insurance so we can respond quickly in an emergency.

5. Photo, Video & Media Consent

By registering your child, you grant Bald Eagle Sports Inc. permission to photograph and video record your child during Program activities and to use such images, video, and your child's first name in Bald Eagle Sports marketing and promotional materials, including its website, social media accounts (Instagram, Facebook, TikTok), email newsletters, and printed materials, without compensation.

If you do not want your child's photo or video used for marketing purposes, please let us know directly — this will not affect your child's eligibility to participate.

6. Governing Law

This agreement is governed by the laws of the State of California. Any dispute arising from this agreement or a Program shall be resolved in the state or federal courts located in Santa Clara County, California.

7. Acceptance of Terms

By registering your child for a Bald Eagle Sports Inc. Program, you confirm that you have read and understood this document and that you agree to its terms on behalf of yourself and your child, including the assumption of risk, release of liability, indemnification, medical treatment authorization, and media consent described above. Registration through our registration platform constitutes your acceptance of these terms.
